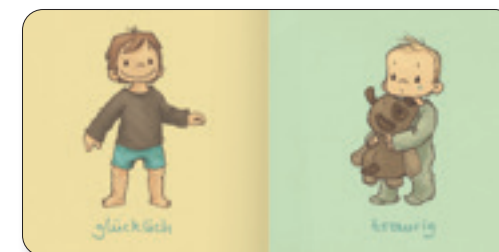

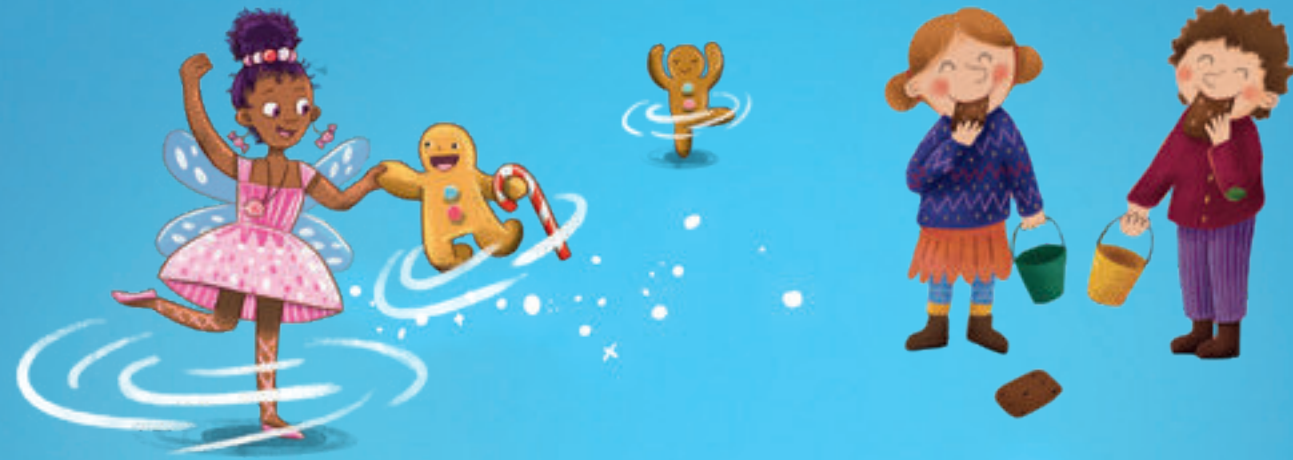

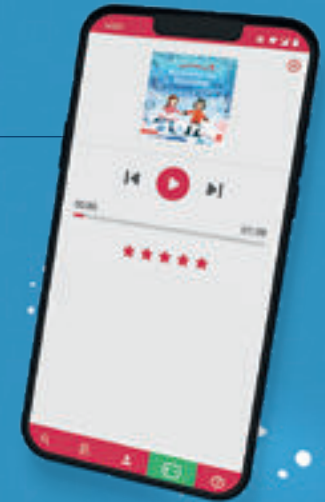
Greta Wagener, born in 1993, grew up near Siegen and discovered her love for stories and illustrations early on. She studied illustration in Münster, where she continues to live and work.
